- Nominees must be employed by a TIA member.
- Nominees must be a woman looking to further their career in tourism and demonstrate potential for leadership.
- Consent to be nominated must be given before submitting someone for nomination.
- Nominations must be submitted via the Survey Monkey form provided by TIA.
- Only one nomination per individual is allowed.
- The competition begins on Wednesday 26 March and ends on Friday 18 April. Nominations must be submitted by Friday 11 April. Any entries received after the deadline will not be considered.
- Nominations will be assessed based on the following criteria:
 - Impact on career: How the scholarship will contribute to their career growth and development in tourism.
 - o Community/Industry contribution: Applicants' contribution to the tourism industry and their potential for future impact.
 - Storytelling Quality: How compelling and authentic their personal story is.
- Shortlist of finalists will be made by TIA representatives.
- Winners will be determined by TIA Chief Executive Rebecca Ingram.
- The decision of the selection panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The winners will be contacted on Tuesday 15 April via the contact details provided in the nomination form.
- If a winner does not respond within three days, TIA reserves the right to select another nominee.
- Winners will be publicly announced on Friday 18 April.
- Winners may be requested to share their journey and raise awareness about the scholarship.
- Personal information collected during the nomination process will only be used for the purposes of the scholarship programme and to contact winners.
